Do You Qualify for LIHEAP?

The Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) is available to qualifying families one time per heating season (October 1 to September 30).

A LIHEAP award is based on household size, household income, heat type, and the household's average heat cost. Energy Awards can range anywhere from \$100 to \$1000.

Your household's **adjusted gross income** must be at or below 125 percent of poverty.

PLEASE BRING THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS TO YOUR APPOINTMENT:

- Proof of Income for the past 3 months for all adults
- Social Security Cards for Everyone in the Household
- Proof of US Citizenship - SS card, US Birth certificate, US passport, Green Card, Permanent Resident Card, etc.
- Photo I.D. for All Adults in Household
- Heating Bill & Heat Vendor Account #
- Proof of Child or Spousal Support
- Proof of College Financial Aid

Do You Qualify for LIRAP Heat?

This program is for Avista customers ONLY. Awards are based on household size, household income, and heating bill usage.

The income guideline for LIRAP heat is 150% Federal Poverty Line (FPL). Please bring all required documents needed for LIHEAP.

NEW! Avista Senior & Disabled Discount Rate Program Avista is replacing the senior outreach program with a rate discount program for eligible senior citizens and customers living with disabilities. Qualified customers will receive a monthly discount on their Avista bill with annual savings anywhere from \$200 to \$1500 based on your usage. Households must be over income for all other programs. Income should fall over 151% FPL but under 200% FPL to qualify for assistance.

Avista Share

Available to Avista customers only, this program can help with up to **\$350** or the amount past due on your energy bill. Please bring your past due notice or shut off notice and your photo id.

Project Share

Available to Inland Power customers and clients with deliverable fuels (Oil, Wood, Pellets, Propane). This program is funded entirely by donations. Funds are limited and may not always be available. The program allows up to **\$300**. You must have a shut-off notice or less than a ten day supply of fuel to receive this help. Please bring your vendor account number and your photo id.
